5. Commit to attending one youth event per week. (For example: Attend Sunday night youth-group, a Friday night hangout, or a weeknight Bible-study. You DO NOT have to attend all youth events, but you must consistently attend one per week)
6. Participate in necessary youth leadership meetings.
7. Live a life worthy of the calling of Christ. Refrain from any activities that would damage your witness as a believer in Christ or the testimony of Monroe UMC Student Ministries.
8. Submit to the leadership and guidance of the Youth Pastor and Sr. Pastor.
